Reply by way of affidavit of Suresh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hathin, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, has been filed, which is taken on record.

As per reply, F.I.R. No.277 dated 19.07.2017 under Sections 323 and 324 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code has been registered at Police Station, Hathin against ten persons and the averments in the petition that the petitioner has moved representation Annexure-P1 on 23.06.2017 is wrong as the same was moved by the petitioner on 11.07.2017 and not on 23.06.2017.

Since the grievance of the petitioner has been met by registering an F.I.R., therefore, this petition is dismissed as having rendered infructuous by declining the prayer of the petitioner for handing over the investigation of the case to some senior officer.
