INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Constable Amandeep Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.04 dated 22.02.2017, registered at Police Station State Special Operation Cell, Amritsar, District Amritsar City, under Sections 399, 402, 307 and 120-B of the Indian Penal code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that in the present case, FIR has been

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registered on the basis of secret information. The present petitioner is stated to be posted as MHC in the police department and involved in this case. One Alto Car is stated to have been recovered from the petitioner. He was not apprehended at the spot and has been nominated by the co-accused.

The petitioner has been in custody since 23.02.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
