Prayer in these petitions filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 63, dated 18.03.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 379, 148, 149 of IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Reply (in CRM-M-25544-2017) by way of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala on behalf of respondent-State has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. As per this reply, it is stated that on the basis of investigation taken up by the SHO, Police Station City Kapurthala and after investigation, the case has been recommended for cancellation to the Senior Officers.
