Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.149, dated 20.05.2016, registered under Sections 420, 382, 383, 201 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala.

Seeking anticipatory bail for the petitioner, learned counsel submits that the petitioner is a lady of about 45 years of age; her sister Paramjit Kaur had entered into Kareva marriage with the complainant-Mohinder Singh and since their relations became sour, she has been falsely implicated in the present case; there is no other criminal case in which she is involved; no recovery of any sort is to be made from her; even if the allegations in the FIR are taken as a gospel truth, which the petitioner does not admit, the same raise only a civil dispute and that under the interim order passed by this Court dated 03.08.2016, she has joined investigation and has fully cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, admits that the petitioner has joined investigation and has fully

cooperated with the investigating agency. He further submits that at this stage, she is no longer required for further questioning.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 03.08.2016, granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.

During the period that the bail is granted to the petitioner, if she is found indulging in any criminal/illegal activity or misusing the concession of bail granted by this Court, it would be open to the State to move an appropriate application before the competent Court/this Court for cancellation of the bail granted to the petitioner.
