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Petitioner-Vijay Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.92 dated 08.04.2017, registered at Police Station Nangal Chaudhri, District Mohindergarh, under Sections 147, 149, 324, 436, 452, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

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I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, ladies of village objected to the liquor vend and two co-accused ladies put the cot lying in the liquor vend on fire. The complainant also received some burn injuries. It is in the evidence that thereafter, some more ladies alongwith the petitioner also came there and they put the liquor vend on fire.

The petitioner has been in custody since 06.06.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
