This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.111 dated 16.09.2014 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Petitioner-Mahinder Kaur @ Mindo is the mother-in-law of the complainant/respondent No.2. The marriage of the complainant/respondent No.2 and son of the petitioner had solemnized on 29.11.2012 as per Sikh rites and from this wedlock, one female child was born. On account of harassment made by petitioner and her family members, FIR has been registered.

Learned State counsel has informed the Court that after presentation of challan, the matter was duly compromised with the parties.

The compromise deed (Annexure P-2) has been annexed with the file.

Mr.Uday Chauhan, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of complainant on 04.08.2016.

Complainant is present in Court today as identified by Investigating Officer of this case. She has handed over the affidavit with the declaration that she has compromised the matter with all the accused.

Consequently, in view of the status report and the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Keeping in view that the complainant has now re-married and has accepted the terms of the compromise (Annexure P-2) and dispute between the complainant and petitioner is general in nature, FIR No.111 dated 16.09.2014 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
