On the asking of the Court, Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4-State.

In this petition, the petitioner, who claims to be a resident of Australia and is currently visiting his native place in India, has sought directions upon the Police Authorities (respondent Nos.2 & 3) to protect his life and liberty and that of his other family members from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 7. His allegations are that he is being pressurized by those respondents, who are in connivance with each other to deliver an amount of ₹8,00,000/- to them, failing which, they have threatened to implicate him in false criminal proceedings.

Without adverting any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction upon respondent Nos.2 & 3 to consider the petition and, thereafter, to act appropriately in accordance with law thereafter.
