Jagjit Singh @ Jaggi versus State of Punjab

Custody certificate of petitioner Jagjit Singh @ Jaggi produced today in the court, is taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition has been made for grant of regular bail under section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure to the petitioner, namely, Jagjit Singh @ Jaggi son of Kewal Singh, in FIR No.108 dated 08.06.2017 under sections 379-B/380 IPC and 25/27 Arms Act and 21/22/61/85 NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

On secret information, the petitioner along with 08 others, involved in various nefarious activities, like dacoity, stealing of licensed arm and selling of narcotic substances as well, was apprehended in the aforesaid FIR. A final report under section 173, Code of Criminal Procedure, was filed against 09 persons, including the petitioner. Out of them, as per learned State counsel, one has been discharged and the other 07 co-accused have been enlarged on regular bail.

According to the prosecution, a revolver 0.32 bore was stolen regarding which a separate FIR No.263 of 2013 was earlier registered in Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar. In the said case also, the petitioner has already been enlarged on bail.

Considering the above facts and circumstances narrated above that seven co-accused of the petitioner have been enlarged on bail and one has been discharged in this case, the petitioner is also admitted to regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court.

The petition stands disposed of.
