A.B. CHAUDHARI, J. (Oral) :

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No. 251 dated 5.3.2017, registered under Sections 399/402 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station City Panipat.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The offences alleged against the petitioner are serious in nature in the sense that the petitioner himself has tried to commit robbery on the police party. There is no other pending case against the petitioner. The witnesses have been examined and have supported the prosecution version also.

The petitioner was arrested on 5.3.2017 and he is in jail since then. Looking to the period of custody and the date of registration of FIR, by this time, the material witnesses have been examined. At any rate, no

useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars ad infinitum as the trial is still going on and will take time to conclude.

In that view of the matter that the trial will take its own time, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order :

ORDER

- (i) The CRM-M No. 25661 of 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner to surrender his passport with the trial Court, if he possesses the same.
- (iv) The petitioner shall attend the police station concerned on every Monday, Wednesday and Saturday between 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. till the trial is completed.
