ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.1 dated 07.01.2015, under Sections 279,337,427 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Adampur, Jalandhar City, District Jalandhar and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise, which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR pertains to road accident between the vehicles of the parties and only minor injuries were received by two persons and with the intervention of the respectables, the matter has been compromised.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 19.07.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to

this Court. The report of JMIC, Jalandhar dated 29.08.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR pertains to road accident between the vehicles of the parties and only minor injuries were caused. The matter has been compromised.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.1 dated 07.01.2015, under Sections 279, 337, 427 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Adampur, Jalandhar City, District Jalandhar and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
