The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking bail in case FIR No.89 dated 16th April, 2017, registered under Section 20 of the Narcotic and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station GRP, District Ludhiana.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Surinder Kumar, PPS, DSP, GRP, Jalandhar on behalf of the respondent-State is filed in Court today; be kept on record subject to all just exceptions.

It has been mentioned therein that there is no record of any other similar case involving the petitioner, who has now remained in

detention for over 3½ months. '*Ganja*' marginally in excess of commercial quantity, was recovered from him, according to the FIR.

In the given circumstances, he may be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Area Magistrate, concerned.
