Petitioner-Gurdeep Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.47 dated 15.06.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Sunam, District Sangrur, under Sections 306 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of respondent and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is named in

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the FIR and active role has been attributed to him. Furthermore, at the time of arguments, it has been brought into notice of this Court that accused of this case used to take the illegal possession of land from the poor farmers and there are some other cases against the co-accused etc.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of specific allegations in the FIR against the present petitioner, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
