Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Pursuant to the last order dated 22.02.2017, learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana has sent a report to this Court. It is clearly stated in the said report that the order dated 21.07.2016 was not put up by the concerned ahlmad of the Court till 17.02.2017, i.e. for a period of 7 months.

Learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana is directed to take action against the concerned ahlmad and sent report to this Court about the action taken .

Learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana has thereafter, proceeded to hold trial and has expeditiously, examined the witnesses. Now the trial is being conducted by the learned trial Judge on day to day basis and prays for further period of two months to complete the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in jail for more than one and half year.

Learned State counsel submits that in total 11 cases are against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner and the same is rejected. Trial Court is granted two months time by way of last chance. Report in respect of action against the concerned ahlmad be sent to this Court within two months.

Disposed of, accordingly.
