Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.86 dated 23.06.2015 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Division No.2, District Pathankot, on the basis of compromise dated 05.07.2017 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide orders dated 21.07.2017 and 08.11.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate on or before 13.11.2017, for recording their statements qua compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report regarding veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Pathankot on 07.12.2017 and got recorded their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide letter No.514 dated 08.12.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Pathankot vide Endorsement No.4179 dated 11.12.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Pathankot, both the parties got recorded their statements voluntarily with regard to the compromise.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.86 is quashed qua the petitioners, subject to depositing costs of ₹10,000/- by the petitioners with the Punjab Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh within one week, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
