The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.356 dated 15.09.2011, registered under Sections 376 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Sadar Palwal.

Heard.

The prosecutrix is present in person. She states that the petitioner has not committed rape on her. A duly sworn affidavit of the prosecutrix has also been furnished in the Court, which is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, informs that the trial is in progress and out of fifteen prosecution witnesses, none has been examined so far.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
