ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.112 dated 31.05.2017, under Sections 306, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioner No.1 is the father-in-law of the deceased while petitioner No.2 is the grandmother-in-law of the deceased. The deceased Harpreet Singh was married to Simranpreet Kaur and due to marital discord, he had filed a petition for divorce under Section 13(7)(1a), (2)(ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 at Mohali on 09.05.2017. He is stated to have committed suicide on 30.05.2017 and left behind a note that his wife had been harassing him and the petitioners were helping his wife.

This Court, by the order dated 02.08.2017, had directed the petitioners to join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction

of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Mohan Lal, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 02.08.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
