By filing the present petition, under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No. 47 dated 24.05.2017, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 376 read with Section 34 of IPC and Section 3/4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

It is contended that the families have decided to solemnize marriage of the petitioner and the prosecutrix. Such an arrangement is acceptable to both the families as is made out from the affidavit dated 26.07.2017 of the complainant/mother of the prosecutrix, which is taken on record as Mark 'A'. The petitioner is in custody since

25.05.2017.

The learned counsel for the complainant admits the factual aspect of the matter.

Heard.

The prosecutrix present in Court heard in person. She states that she is happily residing at her matrimonial home and the arrangement is acceptable to her. Keeping in view the above, without advertng to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate/trial Court.
