Along with this application, civil miscellaneous application bearing No.8603-C of 2017 under Section 151 CPC has been filed for withdrawal of the Civil Suit No.491/94/96. It has been asserted in the application that the parties have settled the matter with the efforts of the Gram Panchayat and the plaintiffs are not interested in now pursuing the present litigation.
