ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.48 dated 17.03.2017 under Sections 498-A/323/506 IPC (Section 406 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an offshoot of a matrimonial dispute which has now been resolved with the intervention of respectables.

This Court by the order dated 21.07.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to the veracity of compromise. The Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Talwandi

Sabo has sent his report dated 10.08.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of a matrimonial dispute, which has now been resolved.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.48 dated 17.03.2017 under Sections 498-A/323/506 IPC (Section 406 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda,, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
