FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Vikas Beri in case registered by way of FIR No.140 dated 11.07.2016 at Police Station Chherretta, Amritsar City, District Amritsar under Sections 420/466/467/468/471 IPC.

During the course of hearing, learned State counsel after getting instructions has made a statement that the petitioner in compliance of the orders dated 05.08.2016 has joined the investigations and nothing has been recovered from him and that he does not oppose grant of bail to the petitioner.

In the light of the stand of the State and since apparently the allegations hover around a money dispute over some sort of business

transaction and the fact that culpability, if any, shall be determined at the trial as well as in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.08.2016 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
