It is contended that FIR No.69, dated 15th June, 2017 under Sections 323, 366, 376, 506 IPC and Section 3 of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Amendment 2015) later on Sections 33 and 89 of the said Act were added, was registered at Police Station Women Police Station, Palwal on the complaint of the petitioner.

Instead of taking any action on the above said, the petitioner, to the contrary is being pressurized to enter into a compromise with the accused persons. In this respect, a representation dated 19th June, 2017, is stated to be submitted before the Superintendent of Police, Palwal, respondent No.2. However, no action has been taken despite the said representation as well.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the file.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of this case, it is considered appropriate to direct respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Palwal to look into representation dated 19th June, 2017 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate action if any/as may be required.

Disposed of accordingly.
