Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.127 dated 03.07.2017 under Sections 447/511/380/427/148/149 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station City, South Moga, District Moga, on the basis of compromise dated 14.07.2017 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

In compliance to the order dated 21.07.2017 of this Court, the parties had appeared before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga on

27.07.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide his covering letter No.606 dated 31.07.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Moga vide Endst. No.4070/EB dated 01.08.2017.

According to the report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga, the compromise between the parties is with their free will and without any pressure from any corner and the same has been made voluntarily.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.127, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
