Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.122 dated 24.07.2012 under Sections 323/341/34 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Sadar Khanna, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise dated 23.12.2016 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 27.01.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court on 15.02.2017 to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties appeared before the Judicial

Magistrate Ist Class, Khanna and got recorded their statements for

compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide her covering letter No.500 dated 02.03.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana vide letter No.1270/EC dated 02.03.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Khanna, the compromise between the parties is voluntary and without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.122, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
