Heard learned counsel for the State.

Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.86 dated 23.06.2017, under Sections 188, 279, 379, 336, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Panjokhra, District Ambala. This Court had made an order dated 21.07.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The State was asked to point out the loss caused to the State vide order dated 21.08.2017. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sub Inspector Sube Singh, makes a submission that the loss caused to the State is ₹71,600/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already deposited ₹50,000/- as per order dated 21.07.2017. He disputed the manner in which the the loss quantified by the State.

This Court cannot go into that question since the petitioner will have to undertake remedy available in law against the order quantifying loss to the State. However, the relief of anticipatory bail should not be declined provided the petitioner deposit the balance amount of ₹21,600/- with the State. It is made clear that the entire amount including ₹21,600/- deposited by the petitioner is without prejudice to his right to challenge the order quantifying the loss to the State.

With the above observations, this petition is disposed of. Interim order dated 21.07.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute. Balance amount of ₹21,600/- shall be deposited within a period of 15 days from today with the office of Deputy Commissioner concerned. Liberty is reserved in favour of the petitioner to challenge the order quantifying the loss to the State.
