Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in terms of settlement arrived at between the parties in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the petitioner has already paid an amount of Rs.1,50,000.00 as per Clause (a) of para 6 (i) of the settlement and another sum of Rs.3,00,000.00 has been paid towards second installment at the time of recording of statements of the parties in first motion in a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

There is no representation on behalf of respondent No. 2 to counter the statement made by counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.08.2016 is made absolute subject to conditions incorporated therein. However, the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of compromise.
