Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that petitioners have since joined the investigation and render full cooperation therein. He has contended that as per his information offences under Sections 452 and 336 IPC have been deleted from the FIR.

Responding to that learned State counsel on instructions from HC Kuldeep Singh from Police Station Sadar, Malaut conceded those facts informing that the weapons have also been got recovered by the petitioners and in that way their custodial interrogation is not required.

Under the circumstances, the interim bail granted to the petitioners on 21.7.2017 is made absolute, subject to their fulfilling

conditions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
