LISA GILL, J. (ORAL)

It is submitted that when the petitioner submitted representation dated 21st April, 2017, the matter was compromised and she was taken back to her matrimonial home in May, 2017. However, she was again subjected to ill-treatment and harassment as before at the hands of her in-laws' family. Her husband had admittedly died in an accident in April, 2010. It is averred that she received compensation in the said case and her in-laws wish to usurp the same. She is also not being given her share in the property. The petitioner, it is submitted was turned out of her matrimonial home again and the custody of her son retained by her in-laws. Thereafter, she again approached the police authorities however, instead of taking any action, she was threatened by the police authorities themselves. Thus aggrieved, the present petition has been filed.

There is nothing on record to show that the petitioner approached the authorities after she was allegedly thrown out of the matrimonial home subsequently. There is no specific date or time mentioned

in the petition as to when the petitioner allegedly approached the authorities.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances above noted but without expressing any opinion on the merits of this case, it is considered just and expedient that in case, the petitioner moves an application before respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib within one week from today, the same be looked into and appropriate action if any/as may be required, be taken thereon. It is reiterated that no opinion whatsoever is being expressed on the merits of this case.
