The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 16 dated 22.01.2017, under Sections 363/366/376 IPC and Sections 11 & 12 of Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the matter has been compromised between the parties by relying upon Affidavit Annexure P-2 annexed with this petition.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State had sought time to verify about the genuineness of the compromise entered into between the parties.

Mr. Abhaypal Singh Gill, learned Asstt. A.G., Punjab, has placed on record the statement of the prosecutrix as well as the complainant in the proceedings under the said FIR wherein reading of the same would

show that both of them have turned hostile.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the statements of the prosecutrix and the complainant have been recorded wherein they have turned hostile, without commenting on the compromise, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
