Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.48 dated 02.04.2017 under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Vide order dated 21.07.2017, the petitioner was granted *ad interim* bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to aforesaid order of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Insp. Jagdish Raj, does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 21.07.2017 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
