Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has informed the Court that pursuant to the order dated 21.12.2016, the petitioner has withdrawn the criminal proceedings and the proceedings in petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act have been finalized. The conditions of the compromise have been complied with.

This Court, vide order dated 11.08.2015, observed that a sum of ₹2,00,000/- was lying deposited with the Registry. A sum of ₹65,000/- was allowed to be withdrawn by the petitioner by way of

cross cheque vide order dated 03.09.2015. A sum of ₹1,35,000/- still remains deposited in the Registry. Pursuant to order dated 21.12.2016 passed by this Court, a sum of ₹2,50,000/- was deposited vide Draft No. 884446 dated 19.12.2016. Now the matter has been resolved amicably.

In these circumstances, the instant petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to withdraw ₹1,35,000/- already lying with the Registry and ₹2,50,000/- deposited vide Draft No.884446 dated 19.12.2016.

In case the petitioner approach the Registry for withdrawing the aforesaid amount, the Registry is directed to release the same forthwith.
