Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.36 dated 2.4.2011 under Sections 323, 341, 325, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpura, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that FIR in question was registered on 2.4.2011 and the case is still at the stage of recording of prosecution evidence. He states that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the trial Court to expedite the trial.
