FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Reports dated 18.11.2016 and 22.08.2017 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana have been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Varinder Kumar, Kiran, Sahiba and Vishal Thapar and the accused persons namely Boby @ Sunil, Happy @ Rakesh, Rupa, Rajni, Kaku @ Viney, Morni @ Oma, Sameer and Avi, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, the fact that the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way

in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.100 dated 11.05.2016 registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
