Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioners seeks regular bail in FIR No.15 dated 4.3.2016, under Sections 302, 450, 323 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

The main accused is Prem Kumar who inflicted blow by means of *kirch* as a result of which Surender Kaur died. Undoubtedly, the petitioners have overt act on their part in the commission of the offence. However, looking to the role played by them and looking to the fact that Ram Murti had given a lalkara while petitioner No.1 is a woman, I am inclined to released the petitioners on bail because counsel for the petitioners makes a categoric statement on instructions from the petitioners that they shall not enter Police District Batala till the trial is completed.

Hence, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty

Magistrate.

The petitioners shall be out to Police Station City Gurdaspur on every Sunday between 11 AM to 4 PM. The trial court will be at liberty to take the petitioners in custody in case the petitioners violate this condition.
