The present petition filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to the official respondents No. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to look into the representation dated 02.07.2017 (Annexure P-1).

Mr. Ramesh Kumar Ambavta, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Let three copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

It has been stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has already moved representation dated 02.07.2017 (Annexure P-1) before Superintendent of Police, Palwal in this regard and that petitioner will be satisfied if respondent No.2, i.e. Superintendent of Police, Palwal is directed to look into the representation dated 02.07.2017 (Annexure P-1), already made to him by the petitioner in this regard.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merits of the claim raised by the

petitioner, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2, i.e. Superintendent of Police, Palwal to look into the representation dated 02.07.2017 (Annexure P-1), in accordance with law, already stated to have been moved to him by the petitioner, in this regard within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
