The petitioner seeks concession of interim regular bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, in FIR No.84 dated 06.10.2015, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at P.S. Mullanpur.

Heard.

The interim bail for a period of two weeks has been sought on the ground that the wife of the petitioner suffered multiple fractures on her leg in a serious accident, leaving her bed-ridden. There is no one in the family to look after her.

Vide order dated 25.07.2017, the State was directed to inquire into the veracity of the assertion with regard to the ailment of the wife of the

petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the matter was inquired into and the assertion made by learned counsel for the petitioner has been found to be correct.

In view of the above, the Court is inclined to grant interim bail to the petitioner for a period of two weeks from the date of his release, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner shall surrender back to the jail authorities on the date and time to be noticed by the releasing Court. The petitioner shall also surrender his passport, if any, held by him.

The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
