Petitioners-Anil Bainsla, Jasvir alias Monu, Rahul, Rohit and Rajesh alias Vikas have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.418 dated 27.06.2017, registered at Police Station Suraj Kund, District Faridabad, under Sections 148, 149, 323 and 506 of IPC and Sections 325 and 326 of IPC.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that it is a case of version and cross-version. There is also allegation that there are four injuries on the person of petitioners. None of the petitioners has been stated to be armed with any sharp edged weapon and simple injuries are attributed to them. It is argued that the parties have effected compromise.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 24.07.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 24.07.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
