This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for setting aside the judgment dated 11.03.2014, passed by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baba Bakala, District Amritsar vide criminal case No.197 dated 16.09.2008 against which criminal appeal No.202 dated 09.04.2014 is pending adjudication before learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar arising out of FIR No. 202 dated 06.10.2007, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 419 of IPC and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise arrived

at between the parties.

It is averred that the compromise in terms of Annexure P-4 has been reached between the parties. Accordingly the parties were directed to appear before the Appellate Court to record their statements. During the pendency of present petition, criminal misc. application No.CRM-8782-2017 has been filed by respondent No.3 to contend that the petitioners have forged his signatures and the assertion of the petitioners with regard to compromise is against the record and has been done to secure undeserving benefit by misleading the Court.

At this stage, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Ordered accordingly.

However, the State is directed to look into the allegations raised in the application by respondent No.3 and take appropriate action as per law.
