Petitioner-Shinda Singh @ Gurshinder Singh has filed this 2nd petition under Section 482 read with Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in Complaint Case No.43 dated 19.11.2010, titled as 'Mukhtar Singh vs. Shinda', under Section 3 (1) (x) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that earlier, the petitioner was granted the benefit of anticipatory bail, but later on in the year 2016, he absented from the court proceedings and was ultimately declared proclaimed offender.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the facts that the petitioner remained absent from the court proceedings for more than one year and was declared proclaimed offender, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
