The petitioner has come in the present petition against the order dated 10.03.2015 passed by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patiala, vide which the application of the respondents for interim maintenance was allowed and the order dated 03.06.2015 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala, whereby the revision petition filed by the petitioner against the said order, was dismissed.

Both the Courts have maintained that the petitioner shall be liable to make payment of ₹4,500/- p.m. as maintenance to his wife and two children. The income of the petitioner has been taken as a daily wager at ₹10,000/- p.m. The other grounds will be decided at the final stage of application filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C.

No ground for interference in the present petition is made out, at this stage. The petition is dismissed accordingly.
