Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.96 dated 30.06.2017 under Section 304-A I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Sector-19, Chandigarh, on the basis of compromise.

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 24.07.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements for compromise with further direction to the Magistrate to furnish report qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties appeared before the Judicial

Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh on 10.08.2017 and got recorded their

statements for compromise. Report bearing No.231 dated 16.08.2017 from the concerned Magistrate duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Chandigarh vide Endst. No.DSJ-EC-2017/10382 dated 16.08.2017 has also been received.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh, the compromise between the parties is genuine, voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.96 qua the petitioner, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
