The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.143 dated 11th June, 2016, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Division No.7, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar.

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that bail bonds of the petitioner in terms of the previous interim order granted in his favour have been executed by the Ld. Trial Court, but still he is in detention on account of pendency of certain other cases against him

It is further submitted that once the petitioner is released, he

shall settle the complainant's claim amicably as submitted on the last date.

From the side of the State also it is submitted that further detention/custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required in the present case.

As such the interim bail granted to petitioner-Harbinder Singh @ Mohit Boparai on the last date, is hereby, made absolute.
