Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0135 dated 28.06.2017 under Sections 382, 186, 324, 323, 427, 201, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 61/1/14 of Excise Act, registered at Police Station Jandiala Guru, Tehsil & District Amritsar.

This Court vide order dated 24.07.2017, while issuing notice of motion, has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to

order dated 24.07.2017, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by HC Balwinder Singh, has stated that in terms of above order, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 24.07.2017 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
