JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.0028 dated 12.05.2017, registered under Sections 354-A, 452, 341 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Hajipur, District Hoshiarpur.

Heard.

On 14.09.2017, the following order was passed:-

“The prosecutrix is unable to cause representation on account of the illness.

Post again on 21.09.2017.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation. In the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any*

inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

The prosecutrix is present in person. She states that she has received Rupees one lakh from the petitioner towards compensation and litigation expenses.

The petitioner has also tendered affidavit expressing his remorse over his conduct with an undertaking that such conduct will not be repeated in future. The affidavit is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 14.09.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
