Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 28 dated 13.07.2015 registered under Section 406/498A IPC at Police Station Women, District Bathinda.

This matter had been referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. It is informed that the parties have reached an amicable settlement. The petitioner and his wife i.e. Respondent No. 2 – Smt. Simarjit Kaur are residing together alongwith their minor child. Respondent No. 2 - Smt. Simarjit Kaur is present in Court. She is duly identified by her counsel. She affirms that she has no dispute with the petitioner any longer. They have decided to live together alongwith their minor daughter. She has no objection in case, the interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 10.08.2015 is made absolute.
