Through this petition under Section 482 read with Section 407 of the Criminal Procedure Code, prayer has been made for transferring the case No.5057 of 2014 titled 'State vs. Baldev Singh' bearing F.I.R. No.10 dated 28.01.2014 under Sections 323/324/506 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Fattu Dzinga, District Kapurthala to the competent Court of jurisdiction at Ludhiana, on the ground that the petitioner who is the complainant in the aforesaid F.I.R. apprehends danger to her life as and when she would appear before the Court at Kapurthala to give her statement as respondent No.2, who is none else, but husband of the petitioner, had given merciless beatings to her and even tried to kill the petitioner by hitting an auto against her. The incident was reported to the police by moving a complaint dated 06.12.2014 (Annexure-P3).

Learned counsel for the State has filed reply in the shape of affidavit of Sandeep Kaur, P.P.S., Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, on behalf of respondent No.1, wherein the deponent has testified that no such incident was brought to the notice of the police by the petitioner.

Considering over all facts and circumstances of the case and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala to provide full protection to the petitioner as and when she comes for appearance in the Court at Kapurthala to give her statement or to pursue the aforesaid criminal case.
