It is submitted that the petitioner submitted a complaint dated 07.07.2017, disclosing the commission of an offence attracting Section 376-D IPC. However, she was pressurized to append her signatures on certain documents at Police Station Div. No.7, Jalandhar. In this respect, an affidavit dated 13.07.2017(Annexure P-2) is stated to be submitted by her before the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar.
