Affidavit of Sulochna Gajraj, IPS, Superintendent of
Police, Palwal filed today in the Court is taken on record.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439
Cr.P.C seeking bail in case FIR No.21 dated 22.02.2017 registered
under Sections 354(C), 365, 376, 452 and 506 IPC at Police Station
Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per
the reply, no trace of obscene photograph or multi-media message
service could be obtained. The prosecutrix has been examined. It is
further contended that the prosecutrix was a consenting party which is
made out from Annexure P-5, voluminous messages exchanged
between the petitioner and the prosecutrix. The petitioner is in custody

since 22.02.2017.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the challan stands already presented; the petitioner is in custody since 22.02.2017; the prosecutrix has been examined so, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/duty Magistrate concerned.
