The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of FIR No.682 dated 30.10.2015 under sections 420, 506 I.P.C (sections 467, 468, 471 I.P.C were added later on), registered at Police Station City Jagadhari, District Yamuna Nagar, on the basis of a compromise dated 31.5.2016 (Annexure P-2) which as per counsel was entered into with the complainant Deepak Chaudhary/respondent no.2.

On 26.10.2016, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Trial Court as regards recording of their statements in support of the compromise and a veracity report in such regard had been called for.

Placed on record is a report dated 19.1.2017 of the learned J.M.I.C., Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari and a perusal thereof makes it apparent that the complainant has failed to appear before the court despite issuance of notices and despite having been given repeated adjournments/opportunities.

In the light of such position of fact the instant petition seeking quashing of FIR only on the basis of an alleged compromise cannot be entertained.

Petition is dismissed.
