The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 75, dated 04.05.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Ladowal, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who is over 62 years of age, was declared innocent during the investigation but she has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. Learned counsel further contends that the injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature and it is a cross case, wherein the petitioner herself received injury on her head.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, I deem it to be a fit case to grant concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Consequently, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall appear before the trial Court and submit her bail bonds to its satisfaction.
