The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 226, dated 03.11.2011, under Sections 302, 307, 379, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR, although the complainant has named seven persons, who had participated in the occurrence and accused Goldi and Dharmender @ Googli had fired shots at the deceased and the injured Sandeep. The petitioner was named by Sandeep later on. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner has been in custody for over 09 months ever since the date of his arrest on 02.11.2016.

Learned Stated counsel has filed custody certificate of the petitioner, which indicates that the petitioner has been in custody for over

09 months.

Heard.

The petitioner is not named in the FIR, although seven persons have been named therein and gun shots and other injuries are attributed to the other accused and the petitioner has been in custody for over 09 months. I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Gurjit Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
